Distributed Learning / Online courses

Start monthly. Distributed Learning provides an alternative for independent and reliable students who require a flexible learning schedule. Courses can be paper-based or online or a combination of online with some classroom instruction. Online teachers provide support and assistance with your course by email, phone and in group tutorials. Individual support is available Mon to Thur in our storefront classroom.

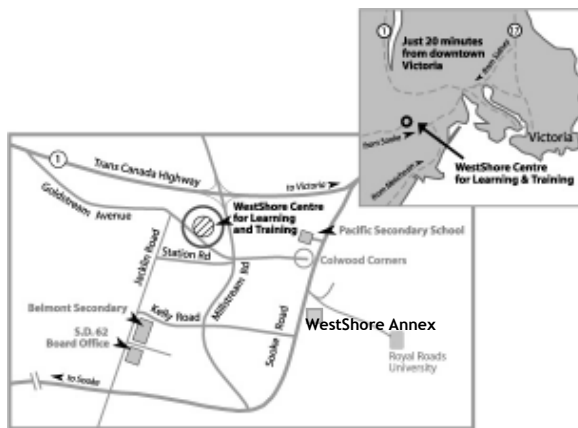
